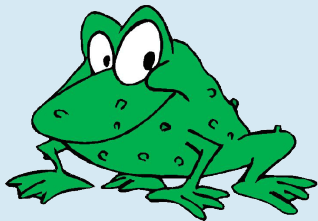
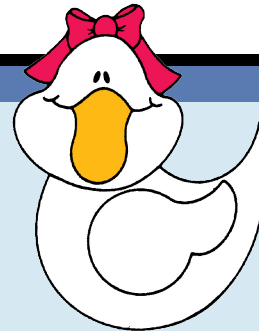


# The Little White Duck

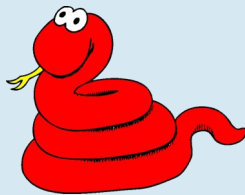
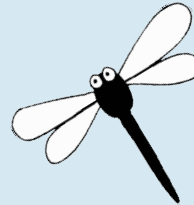
Song
